



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Hainan College of Foreign Studies

(Hainan, the People's Republic of China)

And

BanSomdejchaoprayaRajabhat University

(Bangkok, the Kingdom of Thailand)

Hainan College of Foreign Studies and Ban Somdejchaopraya Rajabhat University desire to work in a spirit of cooperation to establish an academic link between the two institutes. The parties will discuss opportunities for cooperation in the following areas with a view to developing and carrying out collaborative activities of common interests:

- (a) Academic staff cooperation on collaborative research, lectures and conferences in areas of common interest;
- (b) Development and implementation of students and staff exchange programs;
- (c) Identification of special short-term academic programs and projects of mutual benefit to both institution; and
- (d) Any other collaborative efforts that both parties may deem fit from time to time.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understandingshall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity.

This Memorandum of Understandingshall remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by the appropriate authorities of either party giving six months notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The Memorandum of Understandingmay beamended or extended by mutual written consent of the two parties.
